The Humanities Research Center (HRC) awards up to four external faculty fellowships for one-semester appointments each academic year. Fellows receive a stipend of \$40,000 to \$50,000, depending on rank, as well as an allowance for research and relocation to be used during the appointment period. The fellows teach one course affiliated with a humanities department and are in residence at the center during their appointment.

The fellows take part in the intellectual life of the center and university by sharing research activities through a presentation or through participation in a symposium or conference sponsored by the HRC and centered on their research. Applicants should describe how their research project would contribute to the intellectual focus of one or more of the HRC faculty workshops such as African Studies, Cultural Studies of Science and Technology, the Early Modern Reading Group, Global Hispanism, History of Philosophy, Judaic Studies, Medieval Studies, or Poetry and Poetics; or to interdisciplinary humanities initiatives such as the Americas Colloquium or Medical Humanities communities; or to Rice faculty research in the School of Humanities.

Fellowships are awarded to support research projects in the humanities. This includes, but is not limited to, history, philosophy, languages, literature, linguistics, religious studies, art history and the arts. Proposals employing humanistic approaches are welcome from anthropology and other social sciences, natural sciences, music, architecture and engineering. Both junior and senior scholars with tenure or tenure-track appointments at universities or colleges other than Rice are eligible to apply. Ph.D. at least three years prior to appointment.

Applications typically are due early each **November**, and notifications are made each **December**. For details on the application process, please visit **[www.hrc.rice.edu](http://www.hrc.rice.edu)**.
